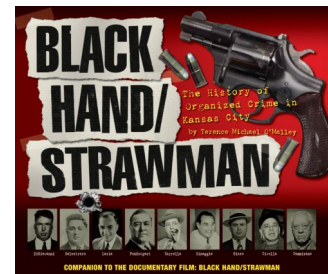

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Summer Corn Salad

Ingredients:

- 5 teaspoons Olive Oil
- 1 Tablespoon Lime Juice
- 1/4 teaspoon Salt
- 1/4 teaspoon Hot Pepper Sauce
- 1 -1/2 cups Fresh or Frozen Corn, thawed
- 1-1/2 cups Cherry Tomatoes, halved
- 1/2 cup Cucumber, finely chopped
- 1/4 cup Red Onion, finely chopped
- 2 Tablespoons Basil, minced fresh (or 2 teaspoons dried)
- 1/4 cup Feta Cheese, crumbled

Directions:

1. In small bowl, whisk 4 teaspoons oil, lime juice, salt, and hot pepper sauce; set aside.
 2. In large skillet, cook and stir corn in remaining oil over medium-high heat until tender. Transfer to salad bowl; cool slightly. Add the tomatoes, cucumber, onion, and basil. Drizzle with dressing and toss to coat.
 3. Let stand for 10 minutes before serving or refrigerate until chilled. Sprinkle with cheese just before serving.
- Yield: 4 servings.
